Slow and steady

The cautious exit from lockdown continues in the country generally, although we remain very aware of the ongoing threat from Covid–19. Sometimes it seems like two steps forward and one step back and that is likely to go on for several months at least.

In our churches in the Hoxne benefice we are also taking a cautious approach. After trying out some services in our bigger churches during July, we will be holding a wider variety of services in a range of churches in August (see list later in the newsletter). But we will still be offering online worship alongside these for those who prefer not to venture out.

We really want to hear from you about what you would like to see for the future. How would you personally prefer to take part in church services? Are there things you have enjoyed during the lockdown that you would like to keep for the future? What have you most missed – perhaps are still missing? What new things would you like to see in our patterns of worship? Is there anything you would prefer we didn't do? Is there anything preventing you from participating as you would like (eg. transport issues, problems with IT)? We would love to know your answers to any or all of these questions, and indeed any other views you may have about our church life in future.

A couple of things you should note if you are planning to attend services in church. First, we are keeping a record of who attends. This is so that we can co-operate with the NHS 'Track and Trace' service if necessary. You have the right to opt out – please let a member of the clergy know if you do not want your presence recorded. All records will, in any case, be destroyed after three weeks. Secondly, we are now all 'strongly advised' to wear masks in church. I know some will welcome this and others not! But remember that you are wearing the mask primarily for the sake of others. Stay safe and well.
