And who can forget the poetry of psalm 65:

You crown the year with your bounty; your wagon tracks overflow with richness. The pastures of the wilderness overflow, the hills gird themselves with joy. the meadows clothe themselves with flocks. the vallevs deck themselves with grain, they shout and sing together for joy.

Jesus himself, as he sends out 70 disciples ahead of him, speaks of a harvest of people: "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest". Words which are picked up in the harvest hymn: "Grant, O harvest Lord, that we/wholesome grain and pure may be".
