Here's a summary of all the services available across our benefice in a normal month.

Communion - For traditional language, it's the Book of Common Prayer. On the first Sunday of the month we have a said one (no hymns) and a short reflection at 8.30am in Hoxne. There is a longer sermon and hymns at Horham (2nd Sunday) and Syleham (4th Sunday) both at 9.30am.

For more modern language, and hymns, there's plenty of choice, 1st Sunday is 9.30am in Redlingfield and 11.15am in Wingfield. 3rd Sunday is 9.30am in Athelington and then 11.15am in Hoxne. On the 4th Sunday it's 11.15am in Denham.

The 3rd Sunday sees Village Praise at 10am in Syleham, again with refreshments but a more formal structure. And the 4th Sunday sees Chatty Church at 10am in Redlingfield. This has a very free format; if you can imagine an 'open mike' approach to church then you've got it.
