#### God save the Queen

This month, of course, we celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee and we think back across the 70 years of her reign. She came to the throne at a time when the country was still recovering from the Second World War – food rationing was still in place. Only about 20% of households owned a car, and a similar proportion had a television – black and white, of course. No-one had a computer. People were very conscious of the threat of nuclear war but oblivious of the dangers of climate change, although the Great Smog in London in December 1952 convinced them of the risks of pollution. Through decades of change, in particular technological change, economic growth and increasing globalisation, the Queen has been a constant. She has served her country and the wider Commonwealth selflessly. Her faith in God and her witness to his love has remained steadfast. So, we shall be celebrating with our villages at events over the holiday weekend and giving thanks for the Queen's long years of leadership in special services on Sunday 5th June.

More summer events are planned after the Jubilee, in particular the annual Redlingfield Dog Show on Sunday 12th June and a garage/car boot sale in Horham on Saturday 16th July. Details later in this newsletter.
