From the Priest-in-Charge

First of all, thank you very much for the many kind messages of support following my licensing by Bishop Mike on 4th October as SSM interim Priest-in-Charge of the benefice of Athelington, Denham, Horham, Hoxne, Redlingfield, Syleham, Wingfield. Thank you too for the beautiful flowers - some of them still beautiful as I write this.

I will be setting up a Benefice Advisory Committee to help steer our future plans for mission and ministry. If you feel this is something to which you could contribute, please let me know. With so much now happening online, we also need a social media strategy group for the benefice. If you have skills in this area, we would love to hear from you!

At the diocesan synod in October, it was reported that our diocese is facing a £1.3 million shortfall because of the drop in parish income caused by Covid-19 conditions. Unless this gap can be made up it will mean a further reduction in the number of paid clergy in Suffolk. As Bishop Martin said, if parishes have been saving for a rainy day, this is the rainy day. If you find that you are spending less because of Covid-19 and have spare cash, do please consider making a special donation to the church.

Finally, the Hoxne and Hartismere deaneries voted at a special meeting on 21st October in favour of a proposal to merge. This was not a decision-making meeting, but the vote will go forward to the Suffolk Archdeaconry Ministry and Pastoral Committee for their consideration. There will then be formal consultation with PCCs before any action is taken. There is lots going on! Stay safe and well. God bless. **Revd Eleanor Goodison**
