From our newly ordained priest......

2020 wasn't very old when it became apparent that it wouldn't be a normal year for ordination to the priesthood. Some training had to be postponed, other training happened via Zoom, and before long there was a question mark hanging over the normal date in June for ordinations.

Bishop Martin is keen on emphasising the priesthood of all believers, the sense that ordained priests are identified from within that larger group, and are supported by that larger group. Holding ordinations in public in the great space that is the cathedral in Bury St Edmunds is a way of conveying that message. But Covid-19 restrictions meant that the number of people in the cathedral for the rescheduled ordinations had to be limited to 30 in total.

Thankfully, different restrictions applied to the service on 13th September when I presided at Communion for the first time. A larger congregation was permitted, and it was great to see so many present. Rev'd Richard, who was preaching, repeated the vows for the priesthood of believers who had not been able to attend the cathedral.

It was a particular delight to be able to hear singing in church once more, for the first time since March. We were blessed too by the weather which meant that post-service refreshments could be enjoyed on the sunny terrace of the De La Pole Arms.

I am extremely grateful for the tangible support that I have received from so many different people, not least the generous gift from the benefice of a silver scallop shell to use for baptisms. I will treasure it and be reminded of my ordination every time I use it. I am also most grateful for the generous contribution that my home parish of Wingfield made towards my book fund. God bless. The Right Rev'd Martin Seeley, the Bishop of St Edmundsbury & Ipswich, advises that as there have been no expressions of interest for the post of Priest in Charge and following discussion and the agreement of representatives from all the parishes, he is delighted to announce the appointment of The Rev'd Eleanor Goodison as SSM interim Priest in Charge in the Hoxne benefice. Eleanor has agreed to do this for an initial period of two years. Bishop Martin and Archdeacon Jeanette are very grateful to Eleanor for the support so far in the vacancy and for stepping into this new role. This opens up new opportunities for mission and outreach and together you can look forward to the future with excitement at what God is going to do. The Bishop would like to thank the parish representatives and all those involved in the process, and he assures you of his prayers. Please pray for Eleanor as she

prepares for her move into this new role.

Wednesday 21st Oct

A special deanery synod Zoom meeting, on the proposal to merge Hoxne and Hartismere deaneries. PCCs have been asked to discuss this so that their representatives are informed of their views, and also to feed back questions or observations about focal ministry as discussed with Bishop Mike. Deanery synod representatives will be reminded of Zoom meeting details nearer the time.

Rev'd Eleanor will be licensed by Bishop Mike at the Communion service at 11am on Sunday 4th October in Wingfield church. We hope to accommodate everyone who wants to attend, but it would be helpful if you could let us know if you are intending to come so that we can plan the use of the space. With current restrictions, due to Covid-19, sadly it will not be possible to have a social celebration afterwards.

Rev'd Eleanor works Friday to Monday and is available for urgent matters on Tuesday and Wednesday. Thursday is her day off. Messages received Thursday will normally be dealt with on Friday.
