### Join the Celebration of the Centenary of the Diocese

There are two services of worship celebrating the Centenary of the Diocese being held on Sunday 6th July at Ipswich Regent Theatre.

#### Be inspired by the past 100 years as we look forward to the next century; Songs of Praise, 3pm:

hearing stories from each decade of how the Church has impacted Suffolk lives, interlinked with favourite hymns and an address from Bishop David.

**Contemporary Worship Service, 7pm:** hearing personal testimonies of how the Church has changed Suffolk lives, interlinked with creative arts, including Pilgrim puppets.

The centenary hymn and centenary children's songs will be featured and led by an orchestra, music group and choir formed from throughout the diocese.

Adult tickets are for a donation of £5 with the option to increase to £10, £15 or £20 – the extra above the initial £5 can be gift-aided by those able to do so. Children U16 are FREE if attending with a 'donating adult'. Group bookings are restricted by ratio to no more than 8

children to every 2 adults. Please note: The 'free children's tickets' must be booked via the box office. This offer is not available online.
