I think that as with developing any skill, the important thing is to keep trying and so I am very excited that this autumn is going to be a season of prayer and there will be a host of opportunities to explore different forms of prayer. The first two events are in September. On Saturday 6th September, we have the dean of the cathedral, Rt Revd Dr Frances Ward, leading a pilgrimage through the benefice. Dean Frances will be with us to lead a walk and prayers from Hoxne church at 10.30am via the St Edmund memorial through Syleham to Wingfield church where there will be a lunch break (helpfully opposite the pub) and then back to Hoxne. Pilgrimage is enjoying a resurgence in Christianity; here is a great opportunity to try a gentle local one before you lace your boots and set off for Santiago de Compostela!

More sedate, at the end of the month we have the first of our deanery prayer workshops; this will be on Saturday 27th September for the morning from 10am in Fressingfield. Each month there will be two different forms of prayer to try out in the workshops, the first workshop being led by Rev Susan on prayers in church and praying for others. All the workshops will be on a similar line of a brief introduction but most of the time spent working with your own prayer-who knows it may turn out that you're better at prayer than you thought!
