#### Flaming June

Because Easter was unusually late this year, Pentecost falls in June - on Sunday 8th June, to be exact. Pentecost is the Greek name for the Jewish festival of Weeks, an early harvest festival. For Christians, it is the day when the Holy Spirit came upon Jesus's disciples in a rushing wind and tongues of fire. The power of the Holy Spirit enabled them to speak in other languages and to tell the polyglot population of Jerusalem the good news of Jesus Christ. So Pentecost marks the foundation of the church.

Jesus described the Holy Spirit as the helper who would be sent by the Father to teach us everything and remind us of all that Jesus himself had said. The Holy Spirit is still at work and we see the fruit of the Spirit in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. And don't we need all those things today?

The Holy Spirit binds us together. This summer we have lots of events which we hope will also bind us together as we enjoy each other's company.
