#### Thy kingdom come

May is here and we all hope the weather might improve! This month we celebrate the Ascension, when Jesus returned to his father in heaven after the forty day period following the Resurrection during which he appeared to his disciples. Ascension Day is Thursday 9th May this year and we will have a deanery service of celebration at 7pm at Palgrave church. Then ten days later on Sunday 19th, we celebrate Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit. Our services for Pentecost will follow our usual pattern (see back page).

When Jesus spoke to his disciples before ascending to heaven he promised them 'you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses'. The disciples responded to this promise by constantly devoting themselves to prayer, day after day, until the Holy Spirit came upon them in power.
