#### **ONLY these items in your recycling bin**

Other items will cause contamination and reduce the quality of recycling



Paper, newspapers, magazines and junk mail

#### paper / card



Books, paperback and hardback



Cardboard, clean food packaging, boxes and cards



Aluminium foil and trays roll foil into a ball

#### metals



Food and drinks cans



Empty aerosols - no paint, fertilizer or weed killer



Plastic bottles - empty, wash, squash and lid on

Plastic yoghurt pots, tubs and food trays





#### DO NOT place any of these items in your recycling bin
